**Region II Tournament Information:**

- 1. Participating players will be admitted in uniform. Only players and coaches will be admitted on the field.**
- 2. Each team will be provided 10 complimentary tickets for the regional semi-final games and the winning teams will be provided 20 complimentary tickets for the regional championship game. The names can be put on a pass list, or you can choose to have the tickets emailed.**
- 3. UIL rules will be enforced throughout the tournament. The game balls and tournament officials are secured through the UIL.**
- 4. There will be no workouts for participating teams on the field.**

5. **There will be a mandatory meeting one hour prior to each game with the head coach and an administrator from each school. The meeting will take place under the videoboard located at the north end of the field.**
6. **Water and ball shaggers will be provided for each match.**
7. **Ticket sales will be online ONLY. We will have people to assist with online ticket purchases at the gate but there will be NO CASH SALES. Tickets are required for 2 years old and above.**

**Home & visiting fans will enter at Gate 3 (press box side)**

**The following passes will be accepted: THSCA, TGCA, TASCO**

8. **The home teams will dress in the home locker room and the visiting teams will dress in the visitors' locker room. All fans will be seated on the press box side of the stadium which is on the opposite side of the team benches.**
9. **CHRISTUS TMF Rose Stadium Clear Bag Policy will be enforced as well as the following policies: NO balloons, confetti, or outside food and drink. Tyler ISD staff will make decisions as needed regarding the entrance of any items into the stadium. If you have any questions regarding these policies, it is recommended you call in advance.**
10. **The playing field at CHRISTUS TMF Rose Stadium is a Hellas Matric Helix artificial playing surface and conforms to NCAA rules and standards. The following is NOT allowed on the playing field:**
  - **Confetti**
  - **Spectators**
  - **Glass containers**
  - **Tobacco, sunflower seeds, gum, and similar type products**
  - **Food or candy**
11. **One official school video camera per team will be provided with a space in the press box. Parents will be allowed to video from the bleachers. They must not interfere with another spectator's opportunity to view the match.**
12. **Spirit sign banners for each participating school will be allowed. They may NOT be taped to concrete walls or fences. All spirit signs must be attached to fences with grommets. Victory lines inside the fence will not be allowed.**

13. **Submit your complete roster form and current record (including playoff victories) to the tournament director prior to 12:00 p.m. on Wednesday, April 3<sup>rd</sup>.**
14. **Tournament pre-game and warm-up time will be provided on the clock for the main field. We will ask the participating teams to line up in the center of the field 10 minutes prior to the match for introductions. Starting lineups and The National Anthem will be played prior to each game.**
15. **Tournament pairings will be determined by the UIL bracket. The top team in the UIL bracket will be the home team. THE HOME TEAM WILL WEAR DARK JERSEYS**
